## JOHN GIANNETTI CAST THE DECIDING VOTE IN FAVOR OF A SWEETHEART DEAL FOR BIG TOBACCO.

### JOHN GIANNETTI:

#### *Delivering for big tobacco.*

After stunning defeats in the courtroom, big tobacco fought to pass a law, right here in Maryland, to let them off the hook when they lose major lawsuits, until every legal delay tactic has been exhausted.

**S.B. 339 would have changed the Maryland judicial system to benefit big tobacco. And when the tobacco lobbyists needed one more vote to pass their sweetheart deal, who did they turn to?**

#### **John Giannetti.**

As a member of the Judicial Proceedings Committee, Giannetti cast the deciding vote in favor of big tobacco's sweetheart deal, giving it a slim, one-vote approval.
